Allen	Mary Allen, who was born in England to Irish parents and died in Renton. She was a friend of Tina Bonfield of Seattle.
Barrett	Jack Barrett, an avid golfer who especially loved golfing in Ireland. For over 50 years, he was a good friend of Tom Glynn of Seattle.
Berry	Thomas Berry who died last June, he was an uncle of Seattle harpist Peter Berry.
Borelan	Marie Borelan, a native of Northern Ireland, who died in Bellevue aged 79.
Boyle	Kathleen Boyle, born in New Zealand but a long time active member of the Seattle-area's Irish community, she died in Federal Way aged 81.
Boyle	Michael Boyle of Shoreline, who died suddenly aged 46.
Brennan	Pauline Brennan of Leitrim who died in Sligo last March. She was the sister of Leo, Seamus, and Seán Brennan and Ann Dolan, all of Seattle.
Brenton	Officer Timothy Brenton, the 39-year-old Seattle Police Officer who was shot and killed in the line of duty on Saturday last and whose memorial service was held this afternoon.
Briggs	Rosaleen Briggs, a native of Belfast who died in Seattle.
Buchling	Eileen Buchling who died in New Jersey. She was a much loved aunt of Seattle's Kevin McTiernan.
Burke	Josephine Burke, the youngest of 13 children, died in Bellevue last December, aged 93. Her Irish-born father, Patrick Downey, in 1882 was the first settler in present-day Clyde Hill overlooking Lake Washington.
Carroll	Mary Carroll, a native of Co. Carlow who died in Seattle aged 91.
Cerafice	Colette Cerafice, born in Derry in 1940, who died in Kelso.
Clark	Nora Joan Clark, aged 85, who died in Shoreline. Joan was born in London to an Irish mother.
Clarke	Patricia Ann Clarke, an active member of the Irish Interest Section, Eastside Genealogical Society.
Clinton	Patsy Clinton who died in Drogheda, Co. Louth. She was a sister of Pat Cummins of Seattle.
Conlon	Brian Conlon who died suddenly in London aged 45. He was the brother of Patrick Conlon of the Kangaroo & Kiwi
Connolly	William Connelly who died in Washington, DC, the father of Seattle's Sara Buettner-Connelly.
Coyle	Cassie Coyle who died in Donegal, the 92-year-old mother of Eileen Doohan of Mountlake Terrace.
Crothers	Billy Crothers, who died in Bellevue aged 67. He was always a proud "Dub", a native Dubliner.
Daly	John Daly, a native of Dublin who died in Seattle last week and was buried in California.
Daly	Margaret Daly, a native of Limerick who died in Longview.

Deegan	Sr. Ann Patrick Deegan, a native of Co. Laois who died in Seattle aged 86.
Deffley	David Deffley, the father of Kara Deffley of Bellevue.
Desmond	Sr. Benilda Desmond who died in LA. Her parents were from Counties Cork and Limerick and she was a good friend of Seattle's Mary Estelle .
Devlin	Patricia Devlin who died of breast cancer last week, a cousin of Deirdre Devlin of Seattle.
Donlon	Frank Donlon of Dublin who died in Melbourne, Australia, aged 46, the much loved brother of John Donlon of Greenlake.
Downes	Dennis Downes, a cousin of Frank Shriane of Seattle
Farrell	Robert Joseph Farrell who died in Dolphin's Barn, Dublin. He was the father of Karen Farrell of Seattle.
Farrell	Sr. Carmel Farrell, a native of Co. Roscommon, who died in West Seattle aged 90.
Feldman	Joe Feldman, a longtime oragnizer of Seattle's St. Patrick's Day Parade whose memorial service was yesterday at Tahoma National Cemetery in Kent.
Ferron	Elizabeth Anne Ferron, born St. Patrick's Day, 1924, mother of Bill Ferron of Seattle.
Gallagher	David Gallagher, a native of Dublin, who died suddenly in Poulsbo, aged 61.
Gilbride	Bridie Gilbride, a native of Mohill, Co. Leitrim who died in Portland aged 98. She was an in-law relation of Mary Charles of Edmonds.
Glynn	Sr. Philomena Rosaire Glynn, a native of Galway who died in Tacoma aged 90. She was a nun for 70 years.
Godfrey	Marge Godfrey, born in Belfast in 1928, who died in Seattle.
Harkin	Frances Harkin, a longtime Seattle resident who died in Portland. She was born in Dublin in 1937.
Harrigan	Kathleen Harrigan of Mukilteo who died just before Christmas last year aged 79. Her father and mother were from Co. Mayo.
Harris	Elizabeth Harris who was born and raised in Ireland and died in Kennewick.
Heaslip	Anne Heaslip who died in Co. Cavan, aged 70, a relative of Laura Martin of Seattle
Hegarty	Rory Hegarty who died in Dublin following a football game. He was a teenage relative of Catherine Boyle of Seattle.
Higgins	Joe Higgins, born in Castlerea, Co. Roscommon in 1923, died in Bremerton.
Hodges	Virginia Hodges whose funeral service is tomorrow in Portland. Two of her grandparents were from Belfast and Dublin, and she was the mother of Seattle's Áine McDonald.
Johnson	David Edward Johnson of Seattle who died suddenly aged 37 and whose funeral was today. He was a nephew of Bill and Maura Barnes of Seattle.
Johnston	Mabel (Heaslip) Johnston who died in Co. Cavan, aged 63, a cousin of Laura Martin of Seattle
Joyce	Terry Joyce, a native of Currane, Achill Island, Co. Mayo, who died in Cleveland, aged 80. He was a great friend of Brendan Gallagher of Tacoma.
Keating	Katie Keating who died in Ireland last November. A friend of many in Seattle, she was also the mother of Mary Shriane of Seattle.

Kelly	Sr. Helena Kelly, a native of Co. Roscommon, who died in Tacoma aged 67.
Kennedy	Senator Edward Kennedy, the best-known Irish-American of this generation, who died in Boston last August.
Keville	Vera Keville, who died last week in Boyle, Co Roscommon, aged 83. She was the aunt of Trisha and Bernie Creaven of Seattle.
Knox	Violet Knox, a native of Co. Louth who died in Eatonville aged 86.
Larsen	Kate Larsen, a Dublin-born resident of Centralia who died in Seattle aged 86.
Larsen	Kathleen Josephina Larsen who died in Finglas, Dublin, last June. She was an aunt of Karen Farrell of Seattle.
Lindsey	Mervin Lindsey who died in Wyoming. He was the 88-year-old father of Nancy Jo Lindsey, choir Member Barbara Gordon's best friend.
Lobsinger	Gertrude Lobsinger who died in Detroit, the Co. Louth-born mother of Seattle's Maureen Keane.
Mangan	John Mangan, a native of Co. Limerick and former Seattle resident who died in Wenatchee aged 94.
McCord	Mary Clarinda McCord, the mother of Jesse, John and Mary Anne McCord of Seattle
McCullough	Alice Georgina McCullough who died in Seattle, aged 91. Alice's mother, Lily McAlerney, fought with James Connolly's Irish Citizen Army in Dublin during the 1916 Easter Rebellion.
McGarry	David McGarry of Seattle, the 57-year-old brother of Seattle's Tim McGarry.
McGee	Robert Emmett McGee, father of Moira McGrath of Renton.
McGowan	Martin McGowan, a 100% Irishman whose funeral was held today at St. Mark's in Shoreline. Born in Spokane in 1923, his family in the late 1800s was heavily involved in the founding of Gonzaga Prep.
McGranaghan	Maureen McGranaghan, born in 1923 in Castleblaney, Co. Monahan, and died in Tacoma two weeks ago.
McGuire	George McGuire, who died in North Carolina. He was an uncle of Nanci Spieker of Seattle.
McManamna	Roger Emmett McManamna, father of Diane Kiel
McNichols	Joseph Edwin McNichols died in Southern California aged 78, brother of John McNichols of Seattle.
Merdich	Catherine Cunningham Merdich who died in Tacoma aged 85. She was born in Ardara, Co. Donegal.
Moore	Margaret Moore who was born in Ireland and died in Seattle last April.
Moore	Peggy Furlong Moore died just before Christmas last year. She was the mother of Catherine Moore Dunn of Seattle.
Morello	Neli Morello, a Seattle Public Schools Special Ed teacher and friend of Nanci Spieker.
Murphy	Bronagh Murphy who died in Carlingford, Co. Louth. She was the 50-year-old niece of Seattle's Dan McKevitt and Bernadette Noonan.
Nelson	Dorothy Nelson, an aunt of Linda Noe of Seattle

Noonan	Stanley Noonan, a well-known professional singer, musician and entertainer in the Big Band era, who died in California two weeks ago aged 96. He was the father of Carol Noonan Klacik of Olympia.
O'Callaghan	Michael J. O'Callaghan who was born in Cork in 1932 and died in Richland.
O'Grady	Brigadier General (Captain) Patrick O'Grady, the 87-year-old father of Seattle's Irish dancing instructor Kathleen O'Grady-Graham.
O'Keefe	Dr. Tony O'Keefe, a native of Cork who died in Gig Harbor aged 78.
O'Reilly	Sean Patrick O'Reilly who died suddenly in Seattle, aged 50. His father was from Co. Westmeath and his mother from Co. Cavan.
Patterson	Joseph F. Patterson who died in Cashmere last May, husband of Patricia Staley Patterson
Patton	"Jerre" Patton, who died in Federal Way aged 88. She was the mother of Jaedean Rooney who lives in Ballinalee, Co. Longford.
Quinlan	Tipperary man Tom Quinlan who died suddenly in Tacoma on Halloween, 2008, aged 70.
Reding	Agnes Reding, who died in Tacoma last month aged 81. She was a native of County Tyrone.
Regan	Nancy Louise Regan whose parents were from Mayo and Galway and who died in Bellevue.
Rowland	Martin Rowland, who died in Co. Mayo aged 88, brother of Finian Rowland of Seattle and John Rowland of Marysville.
Ryan	Christian Brother Daniel Peter Ryan, who taught at Seattle's O'Dea High School for 20 years, and served as dean of students, died in Seattle aged 81.
Sampson	Tom Sampson, a native of Co. Limerick who died in Mukilteo aged 77.
Shea	Former Seattle area residents William Allen Shea and his wife Eileen D Shea who died within three weeks of each other last June in Washington, DC. Bill was a brother of Jim Shea of Seattle.
Sheehan	Carrie Sheehan who died in Seattle, was very involved in Seattle's Irish community in the 1970s.
Smith	Margaret Jane Smith who died last May, was the 92-year-old mother of Jack Smith of Seattle.
Smith	Shelley Vivian Smith who died suddenly from a brain aneurysm . She was the daughter of Lillian & Doug Smith & a friend of Seattle's Anna DeWine.
Sepede	Helen Sepede who died in New Jersey, a much loved aunt of Jane Sepede of Seattle.
St. Martin	Christian Brother Elphege St. Martin, who taught at O'Dea High School in Seattle and also in Zambia and South Africa, died in Seattle, aged 86.
Stack	Florence Stack who died in Monroe. 102 years old, she was born in Ireland in 1907.
Stollenwerk	Fredrick Stollenwerk who died in Vancouver, WA, the father of Diane Stollenwerk of Seattle. The grandson of a woman from Cork, Fred would have been 80 years old today.
Stoole	Ernest Stoole who was born in Dublin in 1930 and who died in Arlington aged 79.
Sullivan	Galwayman Martin Sullivan who died in London, the brother of Seattle's Ann Coyne.
Sutthoff	James Robert Sutthoff, the son of a woman from Galway and father of Catherine Slaton of Seattle

Taylor	Florence Taylor, a native of Belfast, who died in Seattle aged 92.
Terry	Mia Terry, the daughter of Jack & Betsy and sister of Euginia
Topalian	Bridget Topalian, a native of Co. Kilkenny who died in Seattle aged 88.
Walsh	Betty Walsh, an Honorary Lifetime Member of the Irish Heritage Club and a former Honorary Grand Marshal of Seattle's St. Patrick's Day Parade, who died in Seattle aged 87.
Ward	Johnny Ward who died in Seattle aged 98. Both of Johnny's parents were from Donegal.
Wood	Jack Maynard Wood who died last December aged 84, the father of Marsha Lichorowic of Tacoma.
Wood	Philip Stedman Wood who died last November aged 57, the brother of Marsha Lichorowic of Tacoma.
Wortley	"Vic" Wortley, a native of Portadown, Co. Down, who died in Seattle aged 79.
Zimmer	Barbara Zimmer who was born and raised in Ireland and died in Puyallup, aged 89.
